Festival Nominations

The play we entered in this year's Wharfedale Festival, has been nominated for awards in three categories.

The Festival operates on the basis that instead of organisations taking their productions to a central venue, a committee of judges visits the shows in their own settings.

Dramas, musicals, pantomimes and children's shows vie for a series of awards, all announced and awarded at a Gala night in Leeds.

This year Halifax Thespians entered *Welcome to Our Village, Please Invade Carefully* by Eddie Robson, which we staged in the Studio Bar in April.

Directed by Ian Byfield, the play supposed the audience was attending the broadcast of a radio play - with half of the sound effects being delivered live.

The production has been nominated for Best Play, Best Leading Actress (Kirsty O'Brien), and won Best Cameo (Ged Marescaux), for his work opening and shutting doors, breaking windows, operating a knitting machine

and a range of other effects. In the most unusual theatrical production, six cast members play their own characters including a computer, as well as 15 other parts featuring aliens and a printer between them.

BEHIND THE SCENES

Stories about forthcoming Thespians shows

Halifax born Maurice Claypole, author of *The Coiner's Wife* (from July 23rd) has spent much of his life working elsewhere, notably in London and Germany. His published writing has varied enormously from technical tomes on language learning, to short stories, novels and plays.

A Halifax Thespians member, he penned a play for the company produced on video during Lockdown, called *Narrowboat Blues*.

The comedy echoes his passion for canals.

He is now back in the Halifax area and will return to the Playhouse later this year with another of his plays

Keir McAllister's play *The Bench* (from August 27th) premiered at the Edinburgh Festival in 2018, described as a comedy about safe spaces and the people that fill them. He began stand up comedy in 2004 and quickly won prizes.

He has written for many top comics and TV/radio programmes including *Live at The Apollo*, *Russell Howard's Good News*, *Mock the Week*, *8 out of 10 Cats*, *Breaking the News* and many more.

Based Loosely on fact *Moonlight and Magnolias*, by Northern Ireland-born Ron Hutchinson has won acclaim on both sides of the Atlantic since 2004.

Hutchinson has a large pedigree having written extensively for the Theatre, for television, including the series *Connie*, and on radio when Radio 4 presented his five-part *Ship of Lies*, based on some of the legends and myths surrounding the ill-fated Titanic. Having moved to Coventry during school days, his work ranged

from gutting fish, working as a clerk in the Ministry of Defence, and investigating claims for the DHSS before his writing career.

Anne Brook's funeral



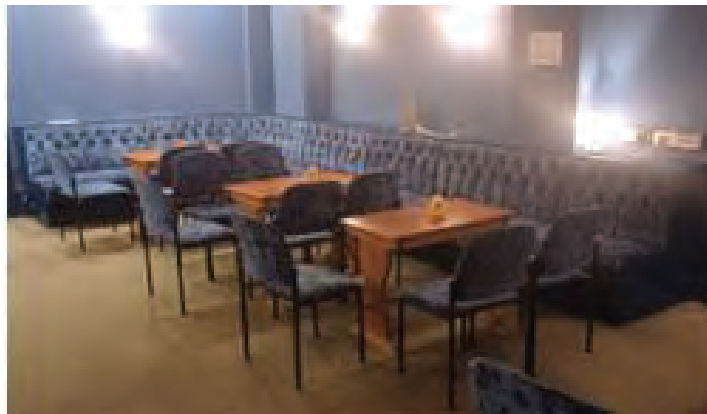
